Entries for all sections will be received up to **7pm** on the Friday night before Show Day. Judging commences at 7.30pm.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions carefully

- 1. Flowers will be judged on quality and arrangement not container
- 2. No entries from commercial businesses accepted, all entries to be from individuals.
- 3. No names or distinguishing marks to be on the exhibits.
- 4. It will be at the judge's discretion as to whether any item is judged if the details requested in the schedule have not been followed.
- 5. Novice exhibitors must not have won a prize in any other show.
- 6. Cut flowers will be sold for show funds.
- 7. No exhibits to be removed before 4.00 p.m.
- 8. Individual prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the judges and judges may give special awards if exhibit merits it.
- 9. No entry fee is payable.

SHOW ENTRY REGULATIONS

- The committee shall have the right to refuse or reject any entry which it deems objectionable or unworthy of exhibition.
- The Judges' decision will be final.
- All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits but no responsibility.
- A fee of \$20 must accompany protests, which will become forfeit if in the opinion of the Committee the protest is deemed to be trivial.
- If, in the opinion of the Chief Steward any exhibit or stock shall be deemed to be diseased or objectionable, the owner of such exhibit shall immediately, upon notice to that effect, remove such exhibit from the Society's ground.
- The Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel any event, through lack of entries or any other cause whatever.
- You enter the showground and exhibit your items knowing you do so at your own risk.

MEMORIAL TROPHIES

- The H.V. Bennett Memorial Award, in honour of "Barny" Bennett, a foundation member of the Show Society, who always showed special interest in roses, is given for the Champion rose.
- Alan Buxton Memorial Award is awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most overall points in Flowers and Floral Art. Alan was a tireless worker in the Flower Section over many years.
- Jan Pettit Memorial Award, first awarded in 1983, is given in the Novice Floral Art Section in honour of Jan, who was a steward for the Flower Section for many years and exhibited and won many prizes for floral art
