HOMECRAFTS RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. All exhibits must be bona fide work of exhibitors, no more than than 5 years from completion, and must be clean and not previously worn.
- 2. It will be at the judge's discretion as to whether any item is judging if the details requested in the schedule have not been followed.
- 3. Novice exhibitors must not have won a prize in any other Show.
- 4. No exhibits are to be removed prior to 4pm.
- 5. No article is to be removed without the production of the exhibitors card.
- 6. All exhibits must be collected after 4pm on Show Day and must be removed by 5pm. If prior arrangement has not been made with the Chief Steward, it will be removed at the owners risk.
- 7. Awards will be given to exhibitors gaining the most overall points in each section.
- 8. Individual prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the judges and judges may give special awards if work merits it.
- 9. No entry fee is payable

SHOW ENTRY REGULATIONS

- The committee shall have the right to refuse or reject any entry which it deems objectionable or unworthy of exhibition.
- The Judges' decision will be final.
- All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits but no responsibility.
- A fee of \$20 must accompany protests, which will become forfeit if in the opinion of the Committee the protest is deemed to be trivial.
- If, in the opinion of the Chief Steward any exhibit or stock shall be deemed to be diseased or objectionable, the owner of such exhibit shall immediately, upon notice to that effect, remove such exhibit from the Society's ground.
- The Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel any event, through lack of entries or any other cause whatever.
- You enter the showground and exhibit your items knowing you do so at your own risk.
